Position Purpose: This position plays a key role in expanding the reach and impact of JWB's Children's Mental Health Initiatives (CMHI) through its focus on workforce development and behavioral health service integration into pediatric and community locations. Serves as lead staff support for JWB's CMHI Design Teams and related subgroups to achieve JWB's goal of developing a high quality, trauma-informed cross-sector workforce focused on prevention and early intervention. Also serves as the internal staff lead to connect CMHI to JWB-funded programs and is the external point of contact for the community.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provides consultation to JWB-funded programs to increase understanding of children's mental health and available resources to support children, families, and program staff.
- Leads efforts to identify, secure, manage and track appropriate clinical and non-clinical workforce development opportunities with supporting direction from collaborative community partners.
- Conducts outreach efforts to potential pediatric practices and cultivates relationships that foster participation in the CMHI.
- Oversees onboarding process of new pediatric practices for CMHI as well as into JWB's portfolio of funded programs.
- Identifies and recommends best practices using evidenced-informed research to support children's mental health and advocates for the adoption of these best practices by community partners to support the workforce.
- Reviews, analyzes and recommends contractual language to support system redesign to enhance care coordination and increased access to children's mental health and other support services.
- Conducts monitoring of CMHI programming to requirements of service delivery, reviews and interprets outcome data against initiative objectives and contractual requirements, and prepares written reports.
- Identifies, recommends, and facilitates collaborative connections to advance strategic goals.
- Participates in workgroups and informational sessions that aid in the development of future strategic planning.
- Prepares visuals and presentations to communicate complex information to different audiences including JWB's Executive Team and Board.
- Interfaces with local government agencies, community groups, businesses, funded agencies, internal units and departments to discuss and promote JWB goals.
- Works cooperatively with cross-functional teams both internally and externally to achieve strategic goals.
- Uploads, classifies, retrieves, and maintains documents in accordance with established Unit/Department record management procedures while adhering to State Laws.
- Performs other duties as assigned or required.

Specifications:

- Bachelor's degree in Public Administration, Mental Health, Health Care Administration, Business Management, Social Work, Psychology, or related field. Master's degree preferred.
- Minimum of 5 years of experience working in one or a combination of: mental health services, public policy, social services, health care administration, business or employee management, quality improvement, or related field.
- Knowledge of and experience with community systems, program design, and implementation.
- Ability to work at both strategic and tactical levels.
- Knowledge of procurement, contract management, and budgeting.
- Knowledge of payment models and local/state/federal regulations relevant to mental health service reimbursement.
- Experience providing technical guidance and leadership support in one or more of the following areas: program implementation, organizational development, mental health/substance abuse programming, family counseling, family support, childcare, and/or youth development/education service delivery.
- Demonstrate interpersonal skills and excellent organizational skills.
- Responsible for participating in periodic in-person community events which may include evenings and weekends.
- Ability to manage multiple projects and deadlines, and work with a variety of stakeholders.
- Self-starter with a solution-focused mindset.
- Excellent oral and written skills.

Additional Requirements:

- Successfully pass a Level 2 background screening as required by Ch. 435 Florida Statutes.
- Possess a valid driver's license and/or access to reliable transportation.
- Drive the JWB van safely as needed, follow all traffic regulations, and adhere to the JWB vehicle policies and procedures.

Working Conditions:

- JWB staff shall reside within the Tampa Bay area. Currently, this is a hybrid remote position and physical presence at the JWB building and other sites in Pinellas County is required as needed.
